This traditional novena is prayed in honor of a miracle that occurred in 1697 at the Cathedral of Gyor in Hungary. That was the year Catholicism was outlawed in Ireland.

On St. Patrick's Day, an icon of the Madonna wept tears of blood and sorrow. The Madonna had been transported from Ireland to Hungary by Bishop Clon for when he sought refuge there in 1649. A replica of the original hangs in St. Stephen of Hungary Church.
